
## Yoga Teachers and Students

Teachers guide their students in yoga, but every teacher is also a student.

All teachers belong to local and national IY associations. They pursue further professional training and certification to better support others in the journey of lifelong yoga. Some more senior teachers also mentor trainee teachers and those working towards higher certification.

## Ramāmaṇi Iyengar Memorial Yoga Institute (RIMYI)

RIMYI was established in Pune, India, in 1975 by B.K.S. Iyengar (1918- 2014) as the home and international headquarters of Iyengar yoga. It provides inspiration, direction and connection with yoga's Indian roots, and develops syllabi to guide practice methods worldwide.
